Note 1: this questionnaire is based on Oldfield (1971). Two bimanual items (from Oldfield's long list) were added to his recommended 10 -items questionnaire to equate the number of unimanual and bimanual items.

Note 2: each "left" answer was scored with " 0 ", each "either" answer with " 0.5 " and each "right" answer with " 1 ". A strong right-handed participant would score " 12 ".
